The state of Michigan With a whopping 1,988 delegates up for grabs, Michigan is the most important state this year. Consider the following numbers: With 11 delegates up for grabs, Michigan is the eighth-largest primary in terms of delegates. (Of those, six are proportional delegates, three are superdelegates, and two are allocated by congressional district.) On March 8, 9 of Michigan's 14 congressional districts will vote, and 5 of those districts (the ones along the state's western and northeastern borders) vote on Super Tuesday, when 12 states will hold their primaries. If Clinton and Sanders are neck and neck in Michigan, Michigan's 10 electoral college votes could become a deciding factor in the nomination battle. 2. The electorate is changing Michigan has become less white, less Democratic, and much more diverse over the last several election cycles. When the census was taken in 2000, 73% of Michigan's population was white. That number was 54% in 2010. And as of 2016, the latest data available from the US Census, a full 32% of the state's population is non-white. In the 2008 and 2012 presidential elections, Michigan went to the Democrats, both times by double digits. But in 2016, Clinton carried Michigan by less than 5 points. That's a huge shift. In 2008, Obama took Michigan by 22 points. In 2012, Mitt Romney carried the state by less than 6 points. In 2016, Trump is leading by 3. What's more, in 2016, Michigan became the first state with a majority of voters living in urban
